NIC Goa State Centre organized a one day state level workshop on National Animal Diseases Reporting System (NADRS) on 21st November 2012 at Seminar Hall, Secretariat, Goa for the officers of Directorate of Animal Husbandry & Veterinary Services, Government of Goa. The workshop was inaugurated by Shri. V. P. Rao, Secretary, Animal Husbandry & Veterinary Services, Government of Goa. Shri. S.B. Barbudde, Senior Scientist from ICAR was invited to give special lecture on Brucellosis and Pest des Petits Ruminants (PPR). About 40 Officers from Block/District/State level offices attended the workshop.

Shri. J.R. Anand, SIO Goa welcomed all the participants. During his welcome address, he emphasized the necessity of implementing e-Governance applications in government departments to deliver citizen centric services and highlighted the objective of establishing ICT infrastructure like Data Centres, Goa Broadband Network (GBBN) of Goa and National Knowledge Network (NKN). The Director of Animal Husbandry & Veterinary Services during his speech expressed that the use of IT in Animal Diseases Reporting would streamline the process and increases the efficiency of the Department. Shri. M. Moni, Deputy Director General, NIC New Delhi addressed the participants through Video conferencing during the inaugural function. During his address, he explained about the overview of NADRS application and conveyed to the participants the implementation plan of NADRS and how the system benefits various stakeholders in the country. The Secretary in his inaugural address pointed out the importance of Animal Disease Reporting and directed the participants to provide all the support to implement the project successfully in Goa. Vote of thanks was proposed by Shri. R. Thangaraj, PSA, State NADRS coordinator.

After the inaugural session, Shri. S. B. Barbudde from ICAR discussed a topic with the participants and shared his views on Brucellosis and Pest des Petits Ruminants (PPR).

In the afternoon, Shri. R. Thangaraj gave a presentation on NADRS and the rolls of block/district/state level officers with respect to Animal Disease Reporting in the new scenario. The preview of NADRS application and the Portal was demonstrated to the participants. SIO Goa assessed the current status of Hardware/Software, VPN status and GBBN connectivity at various offices of the Directorate of Animal Husbandry & Veterinary Services and sought the cooperation of the participants in successfully implementing the NADRS in the state of Goa within the prescribed timeframe.
