

Launch of GST-Goa Portal

Goods & Services Tax (GST) is a comprehensive, multi-stage, destination-based tax that will be levied on every value addition.

GST to abolish the varying levels of taxation between States and considers the country as a single entity when it comes to taxes on goods and services instead of multiple segmented entities. All the sundry taxes will be clubbed into just 2 levels – Central GST and State GST

At the request of the Department of Commercial Taxes, Govt. of Goa, NIC Goa has taken up the computerization project Goa State GST which includes development of Back Office Application for department officials and a comprehensive GST-Goa Portal for disseminating GST related information to all the stakeholders.

As the State of Goa was all set to migrate to GST from VAT from 1st July 2017, just a couple of days before i.e., on 28.06.2017 the Department of Commercial Taxes launched the GST-Goa Portal (<http://goagst.gov.in>) at the hands of the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Goa at a function organized at his Official Residence.
