State Level Training Programme on Immigration, Visa, Foreigners' Registration & Tracking (IVFRT) was conducted at Conference Hall, Police Head Quarters, Panaji on 16.01.2015 at 10:00 AM. The training was arranged and conducted by the IVFRT Team of GOA NIC in coordination with FRRO, Goa. This was the first State Level IVFRT Training Programme in Goa since the implementation of online C-FRO services in June 2014. Considering the importance of achieving 100% implementation in C-FORM & S-FORM implementation, the training programme was mainly focused on C-FRO, C-FORM and S-FORM.

The training programme was started by the welcome speech by the SP & FRRO Goa Shri. Umesh Y Gaonkar. During the speech, he gave an overview about the implementation of IVFRT online services in Goa. He also emphasized on the importance of proper and timely C-FORM submission. During the Theme Address & Overview section, Shri. K N Bahuleyan, IVFRT State Coordinator briefed the various modules included in the project and the status of implementation in Goa. In the succeeding inaugural address speech by the DIG (Range), he mentioned the benefits of having an online system for facilitating the foreigners' services and commented positively on the success achieved so far in the IVFRT implementation in the state.

Training on C-FRO, C-FORM, S-FORM and UCF was given during the training session. Registration and submission procedures for C-FORM & S-FORM were explained to the audience. The challenges facing to achieve 100% C-FORM implementation in Goa and suggestions to overcome these difficulties were explained to the audience during the training program. The various report generation possibilities available in the UCF module was also explained to the audience.

J R Gracias (Assistant Director, Goa Tourism Development Corporation), around 50 DySPs & PIs of Sub-Divisional Police Offices and Police Stations in coastal regions attended the training programme.

The importance of proper C-Form filing was aroused during the Question & Answer session also. The FRRO gave proper suggestions and guidance to the concerned local police stations for their support and necessary action at their end.
